Code of Conduct for Junior players (U18s)

We are fully committed to:

- safeguarding and protecting the wellbeing of all its members and players.
- showing respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Junior Players are defined as those under the age of 18 years, are bound by our policies and procedures and the following Code of Conduct.

- All players' behaviour whilst participating in any cricketing (including training) other activities or when representing us are expected to be of the highest possible standard.
- Bullying will not be tolerated
- All players must play within the spirit and rules of the game and respect officials, coaches etc and their decisions.
- Discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated. All players must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Players should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Junior players are not allowed to smoke or vape whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Juniors are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs (with the exception of medication) of any kind whilst representing the Club.
- Players must adhere to our social media policy.

Any breach or failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action in line with the club's Complaints Process.

Junior players/member and their parents are encouraged to talk to their coaches or the Safeguarding Officer, if they have any concerns.
