Transport

It is the responsibility of parents/carers to transport their children to grounds.

Coaches/volunteers are generally unable to provide transport to children to and from cricket activities and should not pick up or drive off children from the child's home address. It is not the responsibility of the club or coach to arrange transport.

If parents/carers are unable to provide transport for their children they should arrange an alternative method of transportation. When arranging transportation with 3rd parties it is their responsibility to ensure appropriate and up to date driving licence and insurance.

Emergency situations can and do arise and in such circumstances the welfare of the child is paramount, so with parental consent and remembering the rule of 2 children can be transported by coaches/volunteers.

If carers/parents are unable to watch their child train/play they are expected to arrive on time to collect them. If they are not, they should ring the coach at the earliest opportunity to inform they are running late.

We will ensure information is distributed which relates to all planned away fixtures or competitions to provide parents/carers with an opportunity to make appropriate arrangements.

Coaches and club staff will be responsible for children in their care when on the club premises or on arrival at opponents' cricket grounds.

The club must receive permission from parents/carers for children to participate in all competitions and away fixtures/ events.
